- **Identify Normal/Abnormal heart rhythms**
- **Discuss & Demonstrate various dressings for different types of wounds**
- **Demonstrate treatment of a casualty in shock**
- **Discuss & Demonstrate recognition & treatment of casualty's with a variety of medical conditions e.g. Heart conditions, Asthma etc**
- **Demonstrate skills and Identify equipment necessary to assist the Paramedic**
- **Identify recognition features of trauma injuries and demonstrate appropriate treatment**
- **State the importance of Spinal Immobilisation**
- **Demonstrate Spinal Management Skills**
- **Define the effects of a Chest Injury**
- **Demonstrate the treatment of Chest Injury**
- **Define the effects of Ballistic Trauma**
- **Assist the Tactical Advisor on all medical and health issues surrounding an operation.**
- **Demonstrate RTC Management skills**
